# TIGF has seen record levels of gas withdrawals

In recent weeks, TIGF has once again played a crucial role in the country's security of supply in a context of tension in northern Europe, which has led to a sharp rise in prices on gas marketplaces.

**TIGF's underground storage facilities have once again proven up to the challenge and its infrastructure has been in heavy use, with withdrawals reaching record levels.** All consumption needs within TIGF's area of operations were thus met, but the company's infrastructure also contributed to national supply in a context where there were tensions in northern France and several countries were on alert.

TIGF also notes that the growing cooperation between operators and the gradual strengthening of their interconnections are also increasingly contributing to the robustness of the gas sector and interregional solidarity.

With the mild spell over the past few days (combined with a reduction in flows and consumption levels), we are seeing a decrease in tension on the marketplaces. However, the use of storage facilities is still at sustained levels.
